BIOGRAPHY

Asmaa is a Clinical Lecturer/Speciality Registrar in Restorative Dentistry at the School of Dentistry, University of Leeds, UK. She completed her MSc with distinction and PhD at Leeds. For her PhD she developed novel nano-hybrid dental composite with anticaries properties. Her research interests is in the field of resin composites, light curing and amalgam alternatives. She has a clinical interest in rehabilitating tooth surface loss patients with direct resin composites and all aspects of fixed and removable prosthodontics. She published in the fields of dental composites, removable prosthodontics, endodontics and the rehabilitation of oral cancer patients and presented at her work at various national and international meetings.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

To provide the audience with an update on the development of modern resin composites and how to achieve predictable anterior restorations with emphasis on use of resin composites for rehabilitating the worn dentition. The lecture will also discuss the aetiology, prevalence and management of tooth wear using direct resin composites. The hands-on session will provide the full work flow for anterior composites build ups using layering technique and provide clinical tips on how to achieve predictable anterior composite restorations from materials selection to clinical placement and surface polishing.
